DIRECTIONS

From Heraklion Airport (100 km):

Follow signs to Hania (or Chania) and Rethymnon. After about an hour, you will reach the village of Scaletta. Pass through Scaletta and turn right, following the "Old Road to Rethymnon" sign, until you get to Platanes Village. The resort is on the left.

From Hania Airport (60 km):

Follow signs to Hania (or Chania), and then to Rethymnon and Heraklion. After about 45 minutes, take the second entrance to Rethymon and drive towards the centre. There is only one road to Platanes, which is not sign posted. From Rethymon port, take the "Old Road" out of the town towards Heraklion. The resort is situated 10 km on your right.

GETTING AROUND IN CRETE

By Bus

The national bus service, KTEL, operates services on the island of Crete. The service is reasonably punctual and inexpensive. For more information on routes, fares and timetables, visit the KTEL web site at http://www.bus-service-crete-ktel.com/main.html

By Taxis
